Welcome Jeffery Burton, along with his 1979 Spitfire.


Club officers shared their respective information, which is shared with us in the club newsletter.

#### IN LOVING MEMORY OF JIM LARSON

**James Leigh Larson** was born November 12, 1939 in Duluth, Minnesota. He was adopted very soon after that by Gerhard and Edna Larson of St. Paul, Minnesota.

Jim grew up in St. Paul, became an Eagle Scout, graduated from St. Paul Central High School, and went on to the University of Minnesota and St. Cloud State University. He majored in math and physics, with many courses in astronomy. That may have partly accounted for his love of the space program.

After six months of active duty with the National Guard, Jim started working at Control Data, where he spent twenty-five years. During that time he spent four years at Cape Canaveral working on the Range Safety computers. He loved being able to say that he helped to put men on the moon.

On August 15, 1964 he married Lois and exactly four years later, on August 15, 1968 he became a father to Leigh, who has grown to look more and more like him over the years. Sons Dan and Matt came along in 1971 and 1976. He was so proud of all of his boys and all they have accomplished.

Another part of Jim's life was his love of cars and racing. He has owned at least one sports car since 1963 and leaves two behind. He has been an active member of the Minnesota Triumphs for many years. He was into drag racing in high school and college



and won several trophies. Later in life he became interested in autocross racing, which he did until it became too much work to get the car prepared each week. He did pass that love on to Dan and grandson, Tony. Watching Formula One Grand Prix racing on TV was one way for Jim to relax, but he did have the excitement of actually attending the Grand Prix in Monaco five years ago.

Jim and Lois loved to travel, and although he was reluctant to go on his first cruise, he quickly became a fan of cruising and together they visited many places. Several cruises in the Caribbean, one to Alaska with Lois' dad (who Jim loved like his own dad), one to Hawaii, and one to the Mediterranean, plus one river cruise on the Danube and Rhine Rivers were highlights. There were several driving trips around the United States, with many to Cleveland to visit Matt and his family, and some to Reno to visit Leigh's family, and back to the Cocoa Beach/Cape Canaveral area. Each trip we would try to find a new way to go, or something new to see along the way.

Jim has been a member of CCLC since 1978, has ushered, served Communion, and been a faithful member of the Tuesday morning men's coffee group since it started. The good friends he made there are his pallbearers today.


Unfortunately, about two years ago, Jim's heart started to fail, and it has been a long struggle for him. He is finally pain-free and at peace.
