Park the DD outside and dig in.

I think I may pull the body off the TR4. The previous owner put it on a '63 frame so good chance to fix that and swap the rear end for one I put new bearings and seals in. I had a brake line fail last year so a good time to change all the lines as well. May as well re-bush the front suspension too. The transmission has been making an odd noise that radiates through the shifter so I have a rebuilt one ready to bolt up. To round it out I think I will pull the pan and check the wear on the main and rod bearings.

No time frame but there are no trips planned anyways.





Clubs might appeal to their members independently.



on West 7th in St. Paul. The space worked pretty well although the kitchen and wait staff didn't seem to believe that 40+


people would show up. The second big item for the meeting was rain. Lots of rain.
